This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Mr. J. R. Wray of this office on February 16-19, 1982, of activities authorized by NRC Operating License Nos. DPR-31 and DPR-41 for the Turkey Point facility and to the discussion of our findings held with Mr. J. K. Hays, Plant Manager-Nuclear, at the conclusion of the inspection.
