MOTION FOR BOARD ORDER DIRECTING PG&E TO PROVIDE INFORMATION ON IMPLICATIONS OF ERRORS IDENTIFIED IN BOARD NOTIFICATION PNO-5-82-09 AND I&E INFORMATION NOTICE 32-11

Governor Brown hereby moves this Board to direct PG&E to provide full information to the Board and parties on (1) the status of PGwE's investigation into the errors identified in Board Notification PNO-5-82-09; and (2) the status of PG&E's actions pursuant to I&E Information Notice 82-11. The errors addressed in Board Notification PNO-5-82-09 involve block and relief valves and pressurizer heaters which were the subject of contentions heard by the Board during the full-power proceeding in January. The subject of I&E Information Notice 82-11 involves the adequacy of power operator relief valves, an issue also pending before this Board.

The Governor submits that the Staff should have, by formal Board Notification, informed the Board and parties of the matters addressed in I&E Information Notice 82-11. Having failed to do so, however, the Governor quotes from the I&E Notice:

> The inaccuracy of the RCS wide range pressure measurements could lead to pressurizer power operated relief valves being lifted prior to the termination of safety injection and to a greater number of valve challenges, thereby increasing the possibility of a small break loss-of-coolant accident due to a valve failing to close.

In light of the significance of this matter to the pending PORV contention, PG&E should be directed to come forth promptly with all pertinent data.
