## SUBJECT: REACTOR VESSEL IN-SERVICE TESTING INDICATIONS

Ultrasonic testing on April 9 during the unit's 10-year, in-service inspection indicated two possible irregularities near or on the outside surface of the pressure vessel. The indications are located in the plate material below the lower beltline weld about 120 degrees apart. It has been speculated by the licensee that they may be machine marks made during manufacturing.

Carolina Power and Light is currently investigating to determine the relevance of these indications. Region II has sent a metallurgist to the site and is monitoring the licensee's actions. This PN will be updated as further information becomes available. The offices of NRR and IE, as well as the technical assistants to the commissioners, have been informed.

Robinson was shut down on February 27 for refueling and in-service inspection. The unit has now been defueled, and the inspection is continuing.

Media interest has not occurred. Neither the licensee nor the NRC plans to issue a press release at this time. The State of South Carolina has been informed.

Region II (Atlanta) received notification of this occurrence by telephone from the licensee at 8:00 p.m. on April 10.
