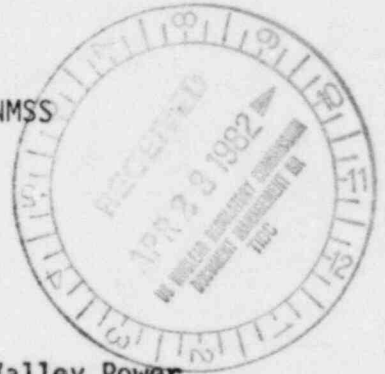

II	6 of 6	In item 3 of the "INTERIM CHANGES" you stated that "These changes will remain effective until the capacity of the automated security system is increased or devitalization occurs in conjunction with the next scheduled refueling outage." To determine the adequacy of these measures, a specific date for the increased capacity of the automated security system is required. Additionally, a firm commitment to utilize the system once it has been upgraded is required.
