We're attaching a summary of the specific questions in our Ninth Set to which we do not believe you supplied responsive or complete answers, and would appreciate your supplying responsive and complete answers at once, so that it will not be necessary for us to again go to the Board with a Motion to Compel.

If I haven't been able to touch base with you about this today, please give me a call as soon as you receive this in the mail tomorrow so you can have it in hand when we talk about it.

Our plans at the present time are to go back to CPSES on Thursday and Friday (April 29 and 30) for more inspection and copying of original documents.

On another matter, we could hardly believe our eyes when we received your letter about the June 16, 1981 Ebasco report. We really had thought that the Board's specific orders to Applicants had taken care of this kind of gameplaying. Apparently we were mistaken. We're frankly quite disappointed in Applicants' actions in this matter.
