complete report will be submitted.

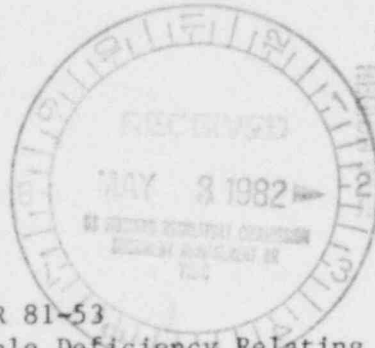
There is no change to the Interim Report at this time.
