DECLARATION OF
JAMES H. MALINOWSKI

- I, James H. Malinowski, declare that:
- 1. I am a supervising electrical engineer in the Generation Planning Department of Pacific Gas and Electric Company ("PGandE"), a position I have held at all times since June 1979.
- 2. In my position as supervising electrical engineer I am responsible for development and analysis of alternative resource expansion plans and assessment of conventional and emerging generation technologies as resource expansion options. In my position I am familiar with PGandE's plans for the siting of future power plants including nuclear fueled power plants.
- 3. PGandE's proposed Stanislaus Nuclear Project consists of two 1200 MW additions to its generating

capacity. As of January 1982, similar generic baseload capacity elements remain in PGandE's resource plans but are now scheduled to become operational in 2001 and 2002. The point at which a construction permit would be required for orderly construction of the Stanislaus project is approximately eight (8) years before its planned operation. In the context of PGandE's January 1982 program, that means the requirement for a construction permit for the Stanislaus project would occur sometime in 1993.

I declare under the penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of California that the foregoing is true and correct and that this declaration is executed in San Francisco, California on May 3, 1982.
