AFFIDAVIT OF LESLIE A. BOWEN

Leslie A. Bowen, being first duly sworn on oath deposes and states as follows:

 My name is Leslie A. Bowen. I am employed by Commonwealth Edison Company as an Engineer in the Byron/ Braidwood Project Engineering Department. In that capacity, I am generally familiar with the design of the Byron Nuclear Power Plant and the equipment installed at the facility.

2. An auxiliary feedwater system is included as part of the Byron design. This system is designed to supply an independent source of water to the steam generators during normal plant start-up, shutdown, and lay-up operations and in the event of a loss of main feedwater supply. The system

consists of two redundant safety-related essential trains and one nonessential train, all of which supply water to the four steam generators. One of the essential trains consists of a 100 percent-capacity direct-drive diesel pump. A separate pump which was manufactured and supplied by Hayward-Tyler Pump Company provides water to cool this diesel driven pump.

3. We have been informed that the NRC Division of Inspection and Enforcement, Region IV is currently investigating allegations concerning the certification of components produced by Hayward-Tyler. At this time, we are unaware of whether these allegations relate to the pumps installed at Byron, or whether the allegations are substantiated. Therefore, we have requested that the NRC Staff keep us advised of any relevant developments in an effort to determine whether there are any safety problems associated with the auxiliary feedwater cooling pumps i.stalled at Byron.

The foregoing affidavit is based on my own personal knowledge and is true in fact and substance.
