SUBJECT: STEAM GENERATOR TUBE LEAK

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Arkansas Nuclear One, Unit 1 was shutdown on May 25, 1982, due to indications of a tube leak in the A steam generator. The tube leak rate was below the resolution level of the RCS makeup system instrumentation (less than 1 gpm). The decision to shutdown immediately was made to preserve the resins in the condensate system. B&W has been notified and will participate in leak location and repair. The outage is expected to last 6 to 10 days. There was no significant increase in offsite release of radioactive materials.

The resident inspector was notified and responded to the site to monitor the reactor shutdown.

Media interest is not expected. Neither the licensee nor RIV plan to issue a press release.

The licensee made prompt notification to Region IV by phone on May 25, 1982, via the HQ Duty Officer.
