Dear Mr. Sreniawski:

I am writing this letter in response to your letter dated April 2, 1982 regarding the inspection of Ms. E. Matson on March 17th. I will respond to your questions in order.

1. Disposal of radioactive material.

At the time of transfer of responsibility of the Nuclear Medicine section the new technologists were apparently informed that detailed record keeping of disposal was not necessary. This was not picked up and while they actually monitored all waste before disposing of it to assure that it was not radioactive, they did not record the results of their monitoring. We have corrected this both by reviewing the procedure manual again with them and our consulting physicist is monitoring these things more carefully now that he has recovered sufficiently from his heart attack to resume activity.

## 2. Leak tests.

We have instituted a cross checking system for leak tests as a tickler file to insure that the leak tests will be performed at least semi-annually. Since Ms. Matson's inspection we have leak tested these sources and found that they exhibit no evidence of contamination. Our standard technique is to wipe test the sources and measure for radioactivity in a scintillation well crystal detector.

Full compliance is now in force and we are assured that we should have no further difficulties.
