I take this opportunity to formally advise you that the design, construction, and initial testing of Grand Gulf Nuclear Station (GGNS) Unit 1 is essentially complete. These activities have been planned and carried out in accordance with the plant's Final Safety Analysis Report and supporting documents. Regarding items not completed prior to the anticipated Unit 1 fuel load, MP&L has evaluated their delay and has concluded that there will be no adverse impact to the safe operation of the plant or to the health and safety of the general public or plant personnel. These incomplete items are evaluted and tracked as described in the Mississippi Power & Light (MP&L) letter to J.P. O'Reilly, dated May 25, 1982, AECM-82/228.

It is MP&L's conclusion that the plant is ready for fuel loading and, therefore, request an operating license for GGNS Unit 1.
