VA HOSPITAL, LOS ANGELES - LICENSE NO. 04-00181-04

Herbert Book and Harry North, Compliance, Region V, called and said V. A. Hospital, Los Angeles (License No. 04-00181-04), had been inspected and that waste burial under the license had been checked. Compliance V obtained copies of maps showing the burial areas and detailed records of how much and what was buried at the 50-acre site under consideration for disposal.

I explained that GSA had written us a letter dated December 9, 1969, stating that V. A. had withdrawn the 50 acres from excess. Their letter crossed ours mailed December 10 to GSA which informed GSA that the Commission places no restrictions on land where wastes have been buried under 10 CFR 20 limitations. Compliance V was surprised at this development since Mr. North was at the V. A. Hospital, December 12, and their RSO did not mention this development and probably wasn't aware of the V. A. decision. Harry North confirmed that all burial records since 1960 indicate disposal in accordance with 10 CFR 20. They agreed to keep the V. A. data on waste disposal in Compliance V files. I agreed this would be advisable since the matter may be pursued by GSA and V. A. at a later date, and the information would be needed.
