Enclosed is the Final After-Action Report/Improvement Plan for the Davis-Besse Nuclear Power Station Radiological Emergency Program Relocation, Reentry, and Return Evaluation and Medical Services Drill. The Mercy St. Charles Hospital Medical Services Drill was held at the Medical Center's Emergency Department in Lucas County, Ohio on October 22, 2019. The Relocation, Reentry, and Return Evaluation was held on October 23, 2019 at the Ottawa and Lucas County Emergency Operations Centers.
