A number of people from Watertown Citizens for Environmental Safety (WCES) and Massachusetts Fair Share are concerned about potential health hazards associated with activities at the Army Materials and Mechanics Research Center (AMMRC), in Watertown, Massachusetts. I am writing to request copies of certain information available from your agency, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. 552.

Please provide us with the following information:

- copies of all the licenses that AMMRC has been issued from either the NRC or the Atomic Energy Commission.
- copies of all the inspection reports on file, of AMMRC; we understand that the NRC is required to perform an annual inspection of AMMRC.

One of our primary concerns is whether there will be any long-term health effects from the chronic exposure of Watertown residents to low level radiation emanating from the army's research center. If you possess any information or reports on the Army Materials and Mechanics Research Center that might be relevant to our concerns, please include them in your reply, or inform us of the material.

If there are any fees imposed for searching or copying the materials I have requested, please inform me of that fact before filling out this request.

I would appreciate your handling of this request as speedily as possible.

This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Mr. C. Rowe and Miss J. McGinness of this office on May 11-12, 1981 of activities authorized by NRC License Nos. 20-1010-04, SNM-244, and SUB-238 and to the discussions of our findings held by Mr. Rowe and Miss McGinness with Major P. Moore and Mr. S. Levin of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your licenses as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and the conditions of your licenses. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, measurements made by the inspector, and observations by the inspector.

Within the scope of this inspection, no items of noncompliance were observed.
