This request is for copies of the final detailed analysis  
of the construction completion schedule for Unit 1. This  
analysis came about as the result of the Caseload Forecast  
Panel Visit to the River Bend site on March 3-5, 1981.

This analysis is said to be complete in the letter of March  
17, 1981 by Robert A. Tedesco, Assistant Director for  
Licensing, Division of Licensing, U.S. Nuclear Regulatory  
Commission. The letter was given Accession No. A-8103230881.  
This latter information is provided in an attempt to shorten  
the agency's search time.


In the unlikely event that access and copies are denied to
