This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. M. V. Annast of this office on July 21-22, 1977, of the UFTR physical protection program provided pursuant to NRC License No. R-56. This refers also to the discussions held with Dr. J. Carroll at the conclusion of the inspection.

The area examined during this inspection was your physical protection program and its implementation. Within this area, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with facility personnel and observations by the inspector.
