I am writing you in regards to the Zimmer Nuclear Power Plant, in Moscow, Ohio. I live within the five mile radius of the plant, on the Kentucky side of the river.

The week of April 19, 1982, the sirens for the Zimmer Nuclear Power Plant were tested. A few of our neighbors and I didn't hear the sirens that week. We live approximately two and one-half to three miles roadwise; one-half of a mile airwise from the sirens.

I have three small children, ages four years, two years and six months, to worry about; also a farm and livestock. Our neighbors have similar worries.

We hear nothing in advance about the activities of the Zimmer Nuclear Power Plant. No one seems to know anything about safety and evacuation plans. Nobody knows anything.

We would like you to look further into

the Zimmer Nuclear Power Plant's safety plans before giving them the license to open. See that the plans are tested and that all the people within the ten mile radius hear and know what is going on. Lives are at stake!
