
Dear Chairman Miller:

On July 1 and 2, 1982, Applicants attempted to depose ten individuals whom CASE identified in its June 23, 1982 letter and June 30, 1982 Motion as witnesses it intended to call during the hearings in the above-captioned matter set to resume on July 26, 1982. Applicants in fact deposed six individuals during that two-day period. Two others were located later, and Applicants decided not to depose them.

However, despite the best efforts of both Applicants and intervenor to locate the remaining two individuals (Messrs. Kinney and Varney), they could not be found and personally served with a Notice of Deposition, and have not been found to date.

Accordingly, Applicants hereby notify the Board that despite diligent efforts to depose Messrs. Kinney and Varney, Applicants have not been afforded the opportunity to do so.
