SUBJECT: TELEPHONE INQUIRY FROM MR. DAN PAPCKE, EPA REGION IV

On Friday, August 10, 1984, Mr. Dan Papcke, EPA Region IV, Cleveland District Office, called to inquire about the activities being conducted in Newburgh Heights, Ohio. It was clarified that the activities were the decontamination of the McGean-Rohco facility and the nearby dump site.

According to Mr. Papcke, a citizen in Newburgh Heights has called the EPA office to inquire about the activities at the dump site. I briefly summarized the current activities, including the fact that work was being done by RMC under contract to Chemetron, that the dump was not under license, that the contamination in the form of depleted uranium was to be reduced to NRC Disposal Option 1 levels of 35 pCi/g, and that the NRC would conduct a confirmatory survey of the site prior to certifying that it was acceptable for unrestricted use. I indicated to Mr. Papcke that Mr. Martin Schumacher was the cognizant individual in the NRC Region III office.
