Gentlemen:

This refers to the routine, unannounced radiation safety inspection conducted by Mr. Wesley Holley of this office on July 31, 1990, of the activities authorized by NRC Byproduct Material License No. 49-21384-01, and to the discussion of our findings held by the inspector with members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

The inspection was an examination of the activities conducted under the license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and the conditions of the license. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews of personnel, independent measurements, and observations by the inspector.

The inspector determined that you had not used sealed sources of licensed material since the previous NRC inspection on April 23, 1987. However, you had continued your use of tracer materials during this interval. The inspector noted that your logging/injection equipment was in adequate condition and observed the loading of your neutron source into a transport package with source handling tools. He also observed that the radiation safety officer (RSO) and other licensee personnel appeared to have effective communication among themselves concerning program requirements.

During this inspection, certain of your activities were found not to be conducted in full compliance with NRC requirements. Consequently, you are required to respond to this matter in writing, in accordance with the provisions of Section 2.201 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations. Your response should be based on the specifics contained in the Notice of Violation enclosed with this letter.


