NRC STAFF RESPONSE TO AMENDED CONTENTIONS

### Introduction

As a result of negotiations among the parties, three environmental contentions (Nos. 9, 19, and 22) were amended and accepted for litigation by the parties. Two contentions were withdrawn. (Nos. 11A and 20). Three of the environmental contentions remain to be decided. By agreement of the parties, the Intervenors CREC have submitted revised contentions Nos. 2 and  $8.\frac{1}{2}$  Contention No. 6 was not amended.

# Staff Response

The Staff supports amended Contentions 2(A and B) and B as appropriate for litigation in the environmental full term license hearing but opposes Contention No. 6.

Although the CREC representative stated on the certificate of service that the revised contentions were served September 19, the postmark on the envelope is September 21.

Contention No. 6 remains the same as originally presented by CREC in its petition to intervene. Staff continues to oppose this contention as outside the scope of this proceeding. Neither the licenses nor the conditions at the two waste disposal sites mentioned are the subject of this proceeding. Staff submits that this contention must be dismissed because it is beyond the jurisdiction of this Board.

# Conclusion

Staff recommends that revised Contentions No. 2 (A and B) and No. 8 be admitted and Contention No. 6 be dismissed.
