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Dear Dr. Asmussen:

We have reviewed the request in your letter dated October 11, 1990, and have determined that granting your request will not adversely affect the common defense and security, nor the public health and safety, and is otherwise in the public interest.

Accordingly, we are issuing a temporary license condition, effective immediately, to Safeguards Amendment SG-1 to your License No. SNM-696 to read as follows:

TC(MC&A)-2 Notwithstanding the requirement of 10 CFR 70.51(e)(4) that activities associated with the physical inventory be completed within 30 calendar days of the ending inventory, the licensee is granted a 10-day extension (from October 16, 1990, to October 26, 1990) for closing the Plant II (TRIGA Fabrication) physical inventory.

Your letter of October 11, 1990, contains information of a type described in 10 CFR 2.790(d). Such information is deemed to be commercial or financial within the meaning of 10 CFR 9.17(a)(4) and shall be withheld from public disclosure unless subject to the provisions of 10 CFR 9.23.
