SUBJECT: FINAL RADIOLOGICAL ASSESSMENT IN SUPPORT OF LICENSE  
RENEWAL FOR THE DAWN URANIUM MILL

The attached subject report on the radiological impacts from operation of the Dawn Mining Company uranium mill has been prepared at the request of the State of Washington's Department of Social and Health Services (DSHS), and reflects incorporation of their comments on an earlier draft. Comments from DSHS were received by letters dated January 29 and March 5, 1982, and were discussed in telephone conversations with Donald Peterson (DSHS) on March 16 and 17, 1982. At the request of the State of Washington, several changes were made in the draft version of the subject report. Briefly, these revisions include:

- o Correction of the geographical location specified for the town of Ford, Washington from that originally submitted by Dawn Mining Company.
- o Updating emission control factors to reflect the most recent available information from DSHS on progressive tailings reclamation plans and actual stack sampling data.
- o Updating previously utilized normalized release rates to reflect the most recent information available.
