Subject: INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT NO. NRC-33-90-217, ENTITLED "COMPUTER TIMESHARING AND RELATED SERVICES"

Pursuant to the Economy Act of 1932, as amended, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and the National Institute of Health (NIH) desire to enter into an agreement whereby NIH will provide computer timesharing services for the operation and implementation of automated systems necessary to the missions of the NRC.

Accordingly, upon your agreement as provided below, the terms and conditions of this interagency agreement are as follows:

Article I - Scope of Work

Objective

The aim of this agreement is to provide computer timesharing services for the operation and implementation of automated systems necessary to the missions of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission. Associated services will include, but are not limited to, the availability of magnetic storage media, technical consulting, training, documentation, distribution of printed reports, and other services as set forth in the NIH/DCRT user guides.

Article II - Period of Performance

The period of performance of this agreement shall be from September 30, 1990 through September 29, 1991. The Scope of Work may be increased during the specified period of performance as mutually agreed to by the parties. The period of performance may be extended by mutual agreement of both parties. These changes shall be incorporated into this agreement by the issuance of modifications to this agreement.

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Article III - Method of Payment

Payments shall be on a reimbursable basis. NIH shall submit invoices in accordance with Attachment A, Billing Instructions for NRC/NIH Interagency Agreement, which is attached hereto and made a part herein.
