Millstone Nuclear Power Station, Unit No. 2 Reply to a Notice of Violation

By letter dated June 28, 1990, (1) the NRC transmitted its Notice of Violation (NOV) relating to Inspection Report No. 50-336/90-09. The inspection was a routine resident safety inspection conducted from April 17 to May 29, 1990, at Millstone Nuclear Power Station, Unit No. 2.

Pursuant to 10CFR2.201, Northeast Nuclear Energy Company (NNECD), provided its response to the subject NOV in a letter dated July 27, 1990. In Attachment 1, page 4, Section 6, entitled Actions to Prevent Recurrence, of this letter, an error was discovered by NNECO after submittal to the NRC. NNECO made the statement that "Certain contract personnel that have long-term assignments with the department have been certified as QA inspectors in accordance with ACP-QA-8.16." This should have read "Certain contract personnel that have long-term assignments with the department have been certified as Certified Testing Personnel in accordance with ACP-QA-8.16."

This error was due to administrative oversight, and NNECO apologizes for any inconvenience this may have caused.
