NOTICE OF ISSUANCE OF AMENDMENT TO FACILITY OPERATING LICENSE

The U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission) has issued Amendment No. 41 to Facility Operating License No. DPR-26, issued to Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc., which revised the license for operation of the Indian Point Nuclear Generating Station, Unit No. 2 located in Westchester County, New York. The amendment is effective as of its date of issuance.

The amendment revises the provisions in the license to conform to an Order of the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board dated June 14, 1978. The license now states that all governmental approvals required to proceed with construction of the closed cycle cooling system have been received.

The Commission has determined that since the issuance of this amendment merely reflects the legal status of governmental approvals, it does not require an analysis of environmental impacts. Pursuant to 10 CFR §51.5(d)(4), an environmental impact statement, negative declaration or environmental impact appraisal need not, therefore, be prepared in connection with issuance of this amendment.
