I see no major problems with this proposed rule. Current license requirements would continue in force with possible additional requirements imposed due to age-related degradation of plant components and parts. The license renewal requires a complete plant assessment, development of plan to deal with plant aging, a public hearing process, and ability for public challenge if any existing requirement is relaxed because of age of the plant or difficulty of compliance with the requirement.

There is no requirement for a licensee to be in compliance with its current license. However, it is difficult to see how a licensee could be out of compliance over the anticipated three year period of license renewal and not have its current license Flagrant violation of license requirements, and/or significant safety violations have resulted in loss of license in the past and would make passage of the renewal difficult if not impossible.

## Specific Questions

- (1) Generating equipment and other transmission related electrical equipment in the switchyard should be exempt from review as they are not part of the nuclear island and are not in contact with any part of the functional nuclear system. This exclusion would not apply to the turbine equipment, especially in a BWR.
- (2) No equipment items or categories appear to be neglected in the proposed rules. However, depending on plant location, biofouling may need to be addressed and the geologic setting may need to be re-evaluated due to changes in erosion or sediment deposition patterns, new or reactivated fault zones, and volcanic activity.
