In summary, this Modification No. Six (6) does the following:

- (1) Exercises the Contract Option Pursuant to Article XV "Option: Services to Perform Response to Public Comments."
- (2) Modifies Article II - Period of Performance.
- (3) Modifies Article IV - Overhead Rates.

Reference is made to CSB's letter and cost proposal of June 11, 1982 which proposes a cost of \$9,948.00 for performance of the Contract Option. However, it is confirmed in the letter that sufficient funds are currently available under the contract to cover this requirement. Based upon the foretated, this Modification No. Six (6) is issued with no additional cost obligated to the Government.

CONTRACT OPTION WORK

The Contractor shall prepare responses to public comments or agency (State or Federal) comments on the Contractor's previous Environmental Statement report which evaluated the tailings management alternatives, and the applicant's interim stabilization, and final reclamation and decommissioning programs. The Contractor shall respond to each comment individually. The Contractor shall revise the Contractor's previous Environmental Statement Section or Sections to reflect comments and responses as appropriate. All of the above shall be assembled to form a single report.

Reports

1. The Contractor shall submit responses to comments and revisions on the Contractor's previous Draft Environmental Statement sections in draft and final form, bound together in a single report, with the following distribution:

Project Officer, NMSS - five copies
Office of the Director, NMSS (ATTN: Program Support) - one copy
Mary Jo Mattia, Contracting Officer - one copy

This draft report shall be submitted to the Project Officer on or before July 23, 1982. The Project Officer will then furnish NRC staff comments on the draft report to the Contractor. Such NRC staff comments are not intended to prejudice the Contractor's technical judgments, but to assure that the draft adequately addresses the work and is clearly and concisely written.

Considering all NRC staff comments received, on or before August 6, 1982, the Contractor shall revise the draft report and submit a final report in eleven (11) copies to the following individuals by September 30, 1982.

Project Officer, NMSS - eight copies plus one (1) camera ready copy
Office of the Director, NMSS (ATTN: Program Support) - one copy
Mary Jo Mattia, Contracting Officer - one copy
