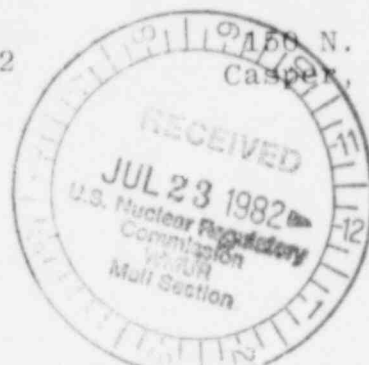

Subject: Annual Land Use Survey

Dear Mr. Scarano:

Pursuant to License Condition No. 70 of the above referenced License, Ogle Petroleum Inc. (OPI) herewith submits an Annual Land Use Survey which was conducted on July 9, 1982. For convenience, License Condition No. 70 is re-stated below:

The licensee shall conduct and document an annual land use survey of all area within one kilometer of the permit area, in order to identify significant land use changes, new residences, and any new offsite well locations. Annual land use survey reports shall be submitted to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Uranium Recovery Licensing Branch, Washington, D.C. 20555, by September 1 of each year, beginning with September 1, 1982.

LAND USE SURVEY

During the Annual Land Use Survey conducted on July 9, 1982, by field reconnaissance, no changes in the land use were observed. All areas within one kilometer of the permit area were observed. Due to the remoteness of the permit area, no changes are expected.

The survey area continues to be utilized seasonally by wild-life and occasionally during the summer months by livestock (cattle and sheep). Grazing intensity appears to be very light in these areas, as the animals tend to avoid this area due to the activities at the mine.

Additionally, no new wellsites have been established within the survey area.
