On July 21, 1982, Del-Aware Unlimited, Inc. filed Interrogatories on the Staff, by which Del-Aware sought information concerning the Staff's evaluation of the Point Pleasant diversion during the AEC/NRC proceeding on the application of Philadelphia Electric Company for a construction permit for the Limerick Generating Station.
