NRC STAFF RESPONSE TO PRESIDING
OFFICER'S ORDER DATED OCTOBER 3, 1990

By Order dated October 3, 1990 the Presiding Officer directed the Staff to submit for inclusion in the hearing file, twelve letters from the University to the Commission listed in amendment number 75 to the University's license 24-00513-32. However, as indicated in the University's September 29, 1990 Response to Intervenors' Renewed Motion for Completion of Hearing File, 10 of the 12 letters were in the supplement to the hearing file submitted by the Staff on August 16, 1990.¹ See, Response, at 12. 
¹The hearing file actually contains 11 of the 12 letters. One was overlooked by the University.


