NRC STAFF RESPONSE TO PRESIDING OFFICER'S ORDER DATED OCTOBER 3, 1990

By Order dated October 3, 1990 the Presiding Officer directed the Staff to submit for inclusion in the hearing file, twelve letters from the University to the Commission listed in amendment number 75 to the University's license 24-00513-32.
