5. The Affidavit of Richard M. Sandvik in support of this motion is attached hereto.



AFFIDAVIT OF RICHARD SANDVIK

I, RICHARD M. SANDVIK, attorney for the Energy Facility Siting Council and the Department of Energy of the State of Oregon, being first duly sworn, provide the following information with regard to the State of Oregon's motion for an extension of time in which to file exceptions to the decision of the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board in this proceeding:

1. The staff of the Energy Facility Siting Council, through the courtesy of the Applicant, Portland General Electric Company, received a copy of the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board's order late in the day on October 10, 1978.

2. The Energy Facility Siting Council is an unpaid citizen body which meets once a month. At its October 10, 1978 meeting, the Siting Council did not have a copy of the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board's decision and did not have the benefit of any analysis or recommendation by the staff of the Department of Energy. The Siting Council could therefore take no action regarding any decision to file exceptions or a motion to stay the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board's decision.


