Sir:

Last year thousands of energy users in the Pacific Northwest area were concerned with the shortage of water power. Now, many of us are observing with concern the idling of PGE Trojan reactor power plant. Many of us feel it is not necessary to shut down Trojan because of potential structural problems in the control building because control of the reactor is still possible in event of the "earthquake" affecting control building walls. Also, another auxiliary control building can be put into use immediately. We also believe the Anti-Nuke protestors are in a minority.

The idling of the Trojan plant has a ripple affect on the economy of this area and during certain periods its availability would be critical.

We ask that we may express our opinions at the October 26th hearing in Portland, and any other hearings.
