Gentlemen:

This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Ms. T. L. Simmons of this office on August 31, 1990 of activities authorized by NRC Byproduct Material License No. 48-18283-01 and to the discussion of our findings with you and Mr. R. Klipstine at the conclusion of the inspection.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, observations, independent measurements, and interviews with personnel.

In addition to the above areas, the inspector examined actions described in your letters dated May 18, 1988 and May 26, 1988, regarding apparent violations found during our April 12, 1988, inspection. We have no further questions regarding these matters.

During the telephone conversation of September 10, 1990 between you, Ms. T. Simmons and myself, it was concluded that since Parker High School does not currently have an authorized user on staff, the license must be amended for storage only with a responsible individual named to assure the security of the radioactive device. Further, when a qualified individual is found to teach the nucleonics course, the appropriate NRC authorization must be obtained before the device is used. It should be understood that no activity is in accord with NRC regulatory requirements unless and until it is specifically authorized in an NRC license.

No violations of NRC requirements were identified during the course of this inspection.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the Commission's regulations, a copy of this letter will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.

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We will gladly discuss any questions you have concerning this inspection.
