SUBJECT: ENFORCEMENT ACTION FOR GLOBE X-RAY SERVICES, INC., TULSA, OKLAHOMA

The enclosed Regional Office Letter and Notice of Violation for the subject licensee are forwarded for your information, since the Notice of Violation contains two violations that we have downgraded. After a review of the circumstances surrounding the violations we decided to downgrade both violations to Severity Level IV violations for the following reasons:

Violation No. 1:

1. The sealed source was in storage and had not been in use since acquisition of the source on August 26, 1981.
2. The material was properly labeled and stored in a controlled area and did not provide any additional radiation exposure to workers or the general public.
3. The licensee did not exceed the total authorized possession limit of this material.
4. The licensee uses and operates devices containing much larger quantities of radioactive material.

Violation No. 3:

1. The licensee's residence is at the same location as the vehicles containing the unsecured material.
2. Although the licensee does not lock the main gate, the property is fenced off to limit access to unauthorized personnel and is located in a remote rural area.
3. There was easy access to the keys left in the unlocked vehicle cabs; however, the storage areas for the licensed material in the vehicle campers were locked.

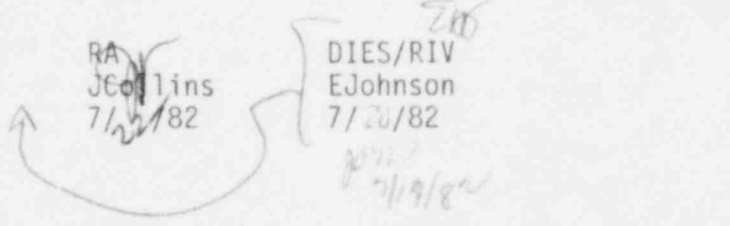
