Dear Mr. Kenyon:

This letter is in response to your request that the NRC be given permission to make copies of individual pages of the ALWR Requirements Documents for its use in reviewing the documents.

EPRI hereby authorizes the NRC to copy pages of the proprietary ALWR Requirements Document when such copies are needed to support review and to aid preparation of the SERs, copyright protection notwithstanding. Copies should be kept to a minimum and destroyed after they are no longer needed. Copies should be considered and treated the same as originals under the proprietary treatment applied for in Reference 1. This authorization is granted with the understanding that any collection of copied pages made from the documents by the NRC will bear the proprietary and copyright notices of the original documentation.

This authorization applies to the ALWR Utility Requirements Documents transmitted on September 7, 1990 (References 1 and 2), unless terminated by LPRI with appropriate written notice to the NRC. Copy authorization for
