Subject: Post Accident Sampling System - Post-Implementation Review

Dear Sir:

In Reference (c), Maine Yankee was notified that the NRC staff will be conducting a post-implementation review of Maine Yankee's post accident sampling system. Reference (c) reiterated the eleven criteria from NUREG 0737, 1tem II.B.3, and further requested a schedule for Maine Yankee's response to those criteria.

In Reference (b), Maine Yankee indicated that the post accident sampling system would be installed and operable by the end of the 1982 refueling outage. Therefore, please be advised that we will provide a response to the Reference (c) criteria by March 1, 1983. This time frame is reasonable, as it allows Maine Yankee to complete installation and testing of the system to assure all specifications are met, and to assemble all pertinent information for the post-implementation review.
