

Attached is a revision to the QA Program Description, Revision 1, which was transmitted by Mr. Goldberg's letter dated April 22, 1981. The revisions describe the procedures that will be used by Bechtel Power Corporation if HL&P requests that it perform limited design work during the transition period while Brown & Root Inc. continues to function as Architect-Engineer on the Project. As described in the revision, during the transition Bechtel will perform its activities in accordance with Bechtel Engineering Department Procedures which implement the approved Bechtel Topical Report BQTOP-1. HL&P QA will perform audits of the Bechtel activities in accordance with the HL&P Project Quality Assurance Plan.

We are planning to submit by December 11, 1981, a description of the QA/QC program that will be implemented upon Bechtel's assumption of project Architect-Engineer responsibilities.




