Dear Mr. Beach:

This is a correction for our letter dated June 20, 1990 which was a response to your notice of violation dated June 7, 1990. The previous response did not address each of the four items specified in the notice of violation.

- Item 1) Reason for occurrence: Safety training was not thorough enough to answer all questions regarding removable contamination surveys and the requirement of the survey.
- Item 2) Corrective steps taken include changing the units of measure from dpm to μCi per 100 cm^2 on documents used to record receipt of radioactive materials, as outlined in 10 CFR 20.205 (b)(1).
- Item 3) Corrective steps to prevent reoccurrence: All licensed personnel have had a review of 10 CFR 20.205 (a-d) and the procedures for receiving radioactive materials, as outlined in the operating and emergency procedures manual provided by ProTechnics International, Inc.
