SUBJECT: BALLOT MEASURE FOR CLOSURE OF TROJAN

Oregon Measure 4, calling for the closure of the Trojan Nuclear Plant, was defeated in Tuesday's vote. With 99% of the precincts counted, the vote was 40.6% in favor of the measure and 59.4% against. Measure 4, supported by the Don't Waste Oregon Committee, would have closed the plant on December 6, 1990 until seismic, financial, and long term waste storage concerns were resolved. Voters turned down a similar measure in 1986 by 64% to 36%.

The licensee will be holding a news conference at 9:00 a.m. (PST).
