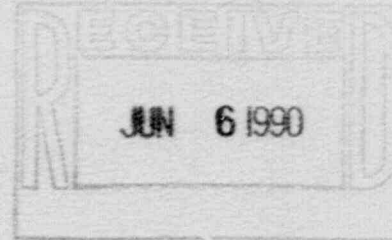

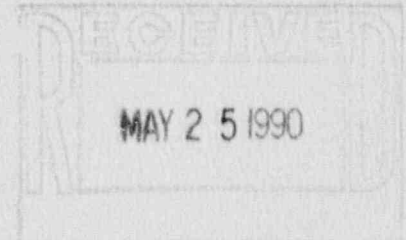

Gentlemen:

We request amendment to the above numbered by-product material license to place limits on the maximum number of Americium 241 sealed sources we may possess at any one time under this license. Please change Item 8A to: no single source to exceed 4.6 curies, maximum 40 curies; and Item 8B to: no single source to exceed 20 curies, maximum of 60 curies (or three sources). The number of sources in Item 8A is not defined because we have both 2.9 and 4.6 curie sources and the combination may vary.

This change will ensure that our Oklahoma stations, at maximum, will possess for well logging purposes an additive total of not more than 100 curies of Americium 241, thus keeping our license under the threshold for establishing financial assurance for decommissioning as set out in the Draft Regulatory Guide, "Standard Format and Content of Financial Assurance Mechanisms required for Decommissioning Under 10 CFR Parts 30, 40, 70, and 72".

Our check in the amount of \$170.00 for the amendment fee is enclosed. If you have any questions, please advise.


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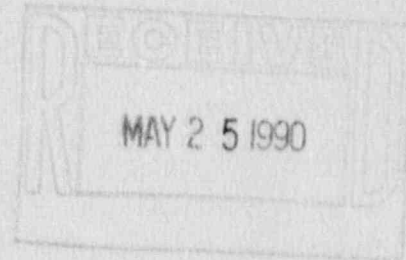

Subject: Financial Assurance Requirements for Decommissioning

Gentlemen:

After review of the draft regulatory guide on financial assurance requirements, it has been determined that Davis Great Guns Logging, Inc. will not have to provide funds, insurance or bonds because the additive quantities of Americium 241 which we possess for well logging operations in NRC jurisdiction fall below the numerical limit of 100 curies set out in the guide. However, upon review of our license, we have found it necessary to amend the license because the number of Americium 241 sealed sources we are able to possess is unlimited. Therefore, we have prepared and enclose herewith an amendment to the above numbered by-product material license limiting our Americium 241 sealed sources to a maximum number of combined curies for 2.9 and 4.6 curie sources to 40 curies, and limiting the maximum number of curies for 20 curie sources to 60 curies (3 sources), making at maximum an additive total of 100 curies. License requirements will thereby ensure that we do not exceed the 100 curie threshold.

It should be noted that Davis Great Guns Logging, Inc. also operates in agreement states. Our trucks have permanent transportation containers mounted in them and there will be occasions that these vehicles from agreement states will be in NRC jurisdiction for the following reasons:

- (1) We buy our electronic equipment from Digital Logging, Inc. in Tulsa, Oklahoma, and they are under contract to maintain all of our electronic needs. Although most of the electronic repair is done at our base stations, there are occasions when equipment updates will be performed at the Tulsa facility. Instructions will be given and efforts made to remove the sources from the trucks before transporting to the Tulsa maintenance facility, however, there may be a few incidences where this may not be possible.
- (2) Davis Great Guns Logging, Inc. operates logging services outside the continental limits of the United States. Occasionally new or remanufactured well logging trucks are delivered to the Port of Houston or roaded to and from Canada. These are fully equipped trucks ready for field operation, complete with radiation sources, and will cross NRC jurisdiction on State and Federal Highways, but will not be involved in well logging operations.



It is highly improbable that these conditions will all come together at any one time wherein the guide's 100+ limit would be exceeded. Efforts in-house will be made through scheduling and on-going logging operations to ensure that the lowest possible number of radiation sources necessary for our operations are maintained. It should also be stated that even though Davis Great Guns Logging, Inc. will not meet requirements wherein we have to provide financial assurance, it is our intention to maintain adequate funds for any decommissioning activities that might be necessary. We have been in business for 25 years and have an honorable record in dealing with the regulatory agencies.
