We have reviewed your letter dated July 24, 1990 (with attached State of Intent) and have determined that the type, form, and quantity of material authorized on your license does not warrant the submittal of certification of financial assurance as described in 10 CFR 40.36(a). This is based on the form of your material, depleted uranium in metal (non-dispersable) form, which is not addressed in our regulations. However, this does not relieve you of record keeping requirements relative to information which the Commission considers important to decommissioning. Please note that License Condidtion 14. requires you to maintain such records as set forth in Section 40.36(f).

We have voided your request for an amendment to your license since you are not required to submit financial assurance for decommissioning.

#### AMENDMENT TO NRC LICENSE SUB-1536

#### STATEMENT OF INTENT

The U.S. Army Tank-Automotive Command (TAGOM), Warren, Michigan is the licensee for Depleted Uranium (DU) Heavy Armor Program operations conducted at the Lims Army Tank Plant (LATP), Lims, OH under NRC license SUB-1536 (Docket or reference No. 040-08994), issued April 30, 1990.

TACOM as the licensee under the foregoing NRC license is responsible for providing financial assurance in the amount of \$150,000 for decommissioning activities at LATP, if LATP were to discontinue any or all operations involving the NRC licensed DU Heavy Armor Program activities. This is based on the type and quancity of licensed source (DU) material as described in 10 CFR Part 40.36(b).

The Commanding General of TACOM, on the foregoing NRC license, will assure that funds not to exceed \$150,000 as described in 10 CPR Part 40.36(B) will be available for such decommissioning. The Jecommissioning funding will be provided to the TACOM Commanding General by the Abrams PM. The Commander is responsible under Army Regulation 210-10 for all activities assigned to or under the jurisdiction of the installation and has the responsibility for ensuring that requisitions and estimates for allotment of funds are properly prepared and submitted.
