RE: Request for an amendment to License Number SUB-1536
dated July 24, 1990.

Gentlemen:

We have reviewed your letter dated July 24, 1990 (with attached Statement of Intent) and have determined that the type, form, and quantity of material authorized on your license does not warrant the submittal of certification of financial assurance as described in 10 CFR 40.36(a). This is based on the form of your material, depleted uranium in metal (non-dispersible) form, which is not addressed in our regulations. However, this does not relieve you of record keeping requirements relative to information which the Commission considers important to decommissioning. Please note that License Condition 14. requires you to maintain such records as set forth in Section 40.36(f).

We have voided your request for an amendment to your license since you are not required to submit financial assurance for decommissioning.

PRIVACY ACT STATEMENT

Pursuant to 5 U.S.C. 552a(e)(3), enacted into law by section 3 of the Privacy Act of 1974 (Public Law 93-579), the following statement is furnished to individuals who supply information to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission on NRC Form 313. This information is maintained in a system of records designated as NRC-3 and described at 40 Federal Register 45334 (October 1, 1975).

1. **AUTHORITY:** Sections 81 and 161(b) of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended (42 U.S.C. 2111 and 2201(b)).
2. **PRINCIPAL PURPOSE(S):** The information is evaluated by the NRC staff pursuant to the criteria set forth in 10 CFR Parts 30, 32, 33, 34, 35 and 40 to determine whether the application meets the requirements of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, and the Commission's regulations, for the issuance of a radioactive material license or amendment thereof.
3. **ROUTINE USES:** The information may be (a) provided to State health departments for their information and use; and (b) provided to Federal, State, and local health officials and other persons in the event of incident or exposure, for their information, investigation, and protection of public health and safety. The information may also be disclosed to appropriate Federal, State, and local agencies in the event that the information indicates a violation or potential violation of law and in the course of an administrative or judicial proceeding. In addition, this information may be transferred to an appropriate Federal, State, or local agency to the extent relevant and necessary for an NRC decision or to an appropriate Federal agency to the extent relevant and necessary for that agency's decision about you.
4. **WHETHER DISCLOSURE IS MANDATORY OR VOLUNTARY AND EFFECT ON INDIVIDUAL OF NOT PROVIDING INFORMATION:** Disclosure of the requested information is voluntary. If the requested information is not furnished, however, the application for radioactive material license, or amendment thereof, will not be processed. A request that information be held from public inspection must be in accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR 2.790. Withholding from public inspection shall not affect the right, if any, of persons properly and directly concerned need to inspect the document.

AMENDMENT TO NRC LICENSE SUB-1536

STATEMENT OF INTENT

The U.S. Army Tank-Automotive Command (TACOM), Warren, Michigan is the licensee for Depleted Uranium (DU) Heavy Armor Program operations conducted at the Lima Army Tank Plant (LATP), Lima, OH under NRC license SUB-1536 (Docket or reference No. 040-08994), issued April 30, 1990.

TACOM as the licensee under the foregoing NRC license is responsible for providing financial assurance in the amount of \$150,000 for decommissioning activities at LATP, if LATP were to discontinue any or all operations involving the NRC licensed DU Heavy Armor Program activities. This is based on the type and quantity of licensed source (DU) material as described in 10 CFR Part 40.36(b).

The Commanding General of TACOM, on the foregoing NRC license, will assure that funds not to exceed \$150,000 as described in 10 CFR Part 40.36(B) will be available for such decommissioning. The decommissioning funding will be provided to the TACOM Commanding General by the Abrams PM. The Commander is responsible under Army Regulation 210-10 for all activities assigned to or under the jurisdiction of the installation and has the responsibility for ensuring that requisitions and estimates for allotment of funds are properly prepared and submitted.
