
Dear Mr. Griffin,

We certify that the material mentioned in this application, namely 6.547 kg U contained in 7.018 kg U of total uranium and the transfer of this material will be subject to all terms and conditions of the Additional Agreement for Cooperation, dated July 25, 1960, as amended.

Further, we certify that CERCA, Romans sur Ysere/ France, as intermediate consignee and Nuclear Research Centre "Demokritos" Attiki/Greece, as ultimate consignee are authorized by Euratom to receive and possess this material pursuant to the aforementioned Agreement for Cooperation.

The above mentioned material will be used for the fueling of the GRR-1 reactor. Edlow International Co., Washington D.C., will ship the uranium to CERCA.
