Gentlemen:

This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Mr. R. C. Brown of this office on June 24, 1982, of the activities authorized by the NRC Byproduct Material License 43-19915-01 and to the discussion of our findings held by the inspector with members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

The inspection was an examination of the activities conducted under the license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations, and the conditions of the license. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews of personnel, independent measurements, and observations by the inspector.

Mr. Brown also reviewed the action you had taken with respect to six violations observed during our previous inspection, which was conducted June 15-16, 1981. He verified that the corrective actions with respect to these items were implemented as stated in your reply of July 21, 1981, to our letter dated July 14, 1981. However, it was observed that one of these violations had recurred during the period of this inspection. This single recurring violation and the pertinent requirements are listed as item 2 of the enclosed Notice of Violation.

During this inspection certain of your activities were found not to be conducted in full compliance with NRC requirements. Consequently, you are required to respond to this matter, in writing, in accordance with the provisions of Section 2.201 of the NRC "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations. Your response should be based on the specifics contained in the Notice of Violation attached to this letter.
