The corrective action forwarded in the referenced response noted that 125 pipe spools supplied by Texas Pipe were to be inspected for minimum wall thickness requirements.

This inspection has been completed and 2 pipe spools were found with minimum wall thickness violations. Hence a 100% inspection of Q-listed spools supplied by Texas Pipe will be performed. The inspection will be completed by December 30, 1982.
