NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Logan Regional Hospital

As a result of the inspection conducted on May 4, 1982, and in accordance with the NRC Enforcement Policy (10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C), 47 FR 9987 (March 9, 1982), the following violations were identified:

- License Condition 14 requires, in part, that licensed activities be conducted in accordance with statements, representations, and procedures contained in your letter dated September 30, 1977.
 - a. Item 5 of the letter dated September 30, 1977, states, in part, that daily source checks will be conducted on the dose calibrator.

Contrary to this requirement, daily source checks were not conducted on the dose calibrator during the period April 22, 1982, to May 4, 1982.

b. Item 8 of the letter dated September 30, 1977, states, in part, that the medical isotope committee will meet every 3 months.

Contrary to this requirement, the medical isotope committee only conducted meetings once in the calendar year 1979 and twice in the calendar years 1980 and 1981.

c. Item 11 of the letter dated September 30, 1977, states, in part, that surveys in the elution and preparation areas will be performed daily.

Contrary to this requirement, daily surveys in the elution and preparation areas were not conducted during the period December 5, 1978, to May 4, 1982.

d. Item 11 of the letter dated September 30, 1977, states, in part, that surveys in areas where possible contamination may occur will be performed weekly.

Contrary to this requirement, weekly surveys in the required areas were not conducted during the period March 22, 1982, to May 4, 1982.

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e. Item 12 of the letter dated September 30, 1977, states, in part, that waste will be monitored prior to disposal and records kept.

Contrary to this requirement, monitoring records for waste disposal were not maintained during the period December 5, 1978, to May 4, 1982.

This is a Severity Level IV violation (Supplement VI.D.2).

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, Logan Regional Hospital is hereby required to submit to this office, within 30 days of the date of this Notice, a written statement or explanation in reply, including:

(1) the corrective steps which have been taken and the results achieved;

(2) the corrective steps which will be taken to avoid further violations; and

(3) the date when full compliance will be achieved.

Consideration may be given to extending your response time for good cause shown.
