Subject: Inspection No. 82-01

This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Mr. C. Stearns of this office on June 29, 1982 of activities authorized by NRC License No. 06-00200-03 and to the discussions of our findings held by Mr. Stearns with Mr. Kennelly of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection, and to a subsequent telephone discussion between Mr. Stearns and Ms. M. A. Pearsall on July 20, 1982.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, measurements made by the inspector, and observations by the inspector.

Our inspector also verified the steps you have taken to correct the violations brought to your attention in the enclosure to our letter dated January 2, 1981. We have no further questions regarding your action at this time.

Within the scope of this inspection, no violations were observed.

In accordance with Section 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, a copy of this letter will be placed in the Public Document Room.
