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

The Atomic Safety and Licensing Appeal Board's Memorandum and Order of April 15, 1982, requires licensee Sacramento Municipal Utility District to notify the Board ". . . at least three business days prior to the scheduled return of the Rancho Seco facility to operation."

Pursuant to that requirement, Licensee hereby notifies the Appeal Board that the Rancho Seco facility is scheduled to reach criticality on or about August 21, 1982. Because of uncertainties
